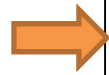




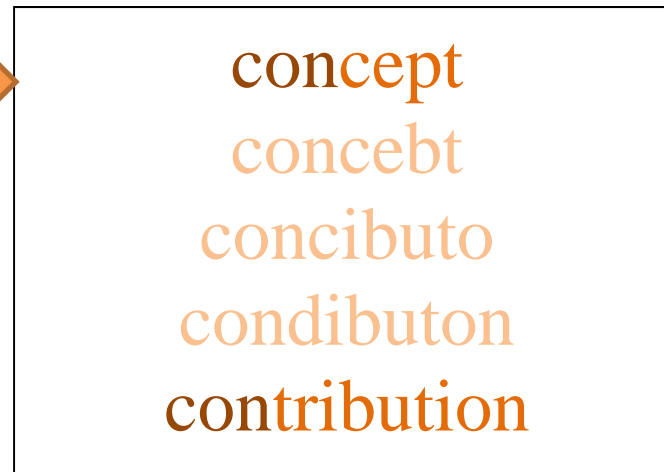

from the Latin conceptum, past participle of
concipere, meaning “to conceive.”



something that has played a
significant part in bringing
about an end or result

from the Latin contribut-, meaning “brought
together, added,” or contributus, from com- +
tribuere, meaning “to grant or bestow.” The root
of tribuere is tribus, or tribe.

When we move from concept to contribution, something that has originated in our mind becomes something that is added to the bounty of the tribe.
